

# Norfolk Triumph Scatter Treasure Hunt for Drive it Day, Sunday 27th April 2025

A 50 mile (approx) drive around north west Norfolk visiting sites and places of special interest you might not otherwise see.

You will need a camera/mobile phone camera, road map and a SatNav would be a distinct advantage. There aren't any start or finish points. Rather you choose the order in which you do the route. **Important! You need to arrive at your chosen start point between 10 and 10.30am.** There will be a short walk at each stop point to find the answers to the clues.

This year there is a **lunchtime gathering** at Gt Bircham Windmill, PE31 6SJ between 12 and 1pm. Free entry to the cafe, bakery, gift shop and toilets. There is an entrance charge to climb the mill. Please bring your own chairs if picnicking.

Some of the venues could well be busy with members of the public - please be considerate to other visitors.

This is not a timed event, rather an enjoyable amble through the Norfolk countryside and we urge you to take the time to explore the places of interest we have chosen.

Some roads are narrow with blind bends. Please be careful of horses, cyclists and walkers.

We advise entrants not to bunch up or form convoys and to respect other road users.

Do as little or as much as you want. While it's not important to visit all the places, the more you do the better your chance of winning.

Points will be awarded as follows:

Correct answer: 3pts per clue

Photographing your car at any one stop point: 3pts (points only given once)

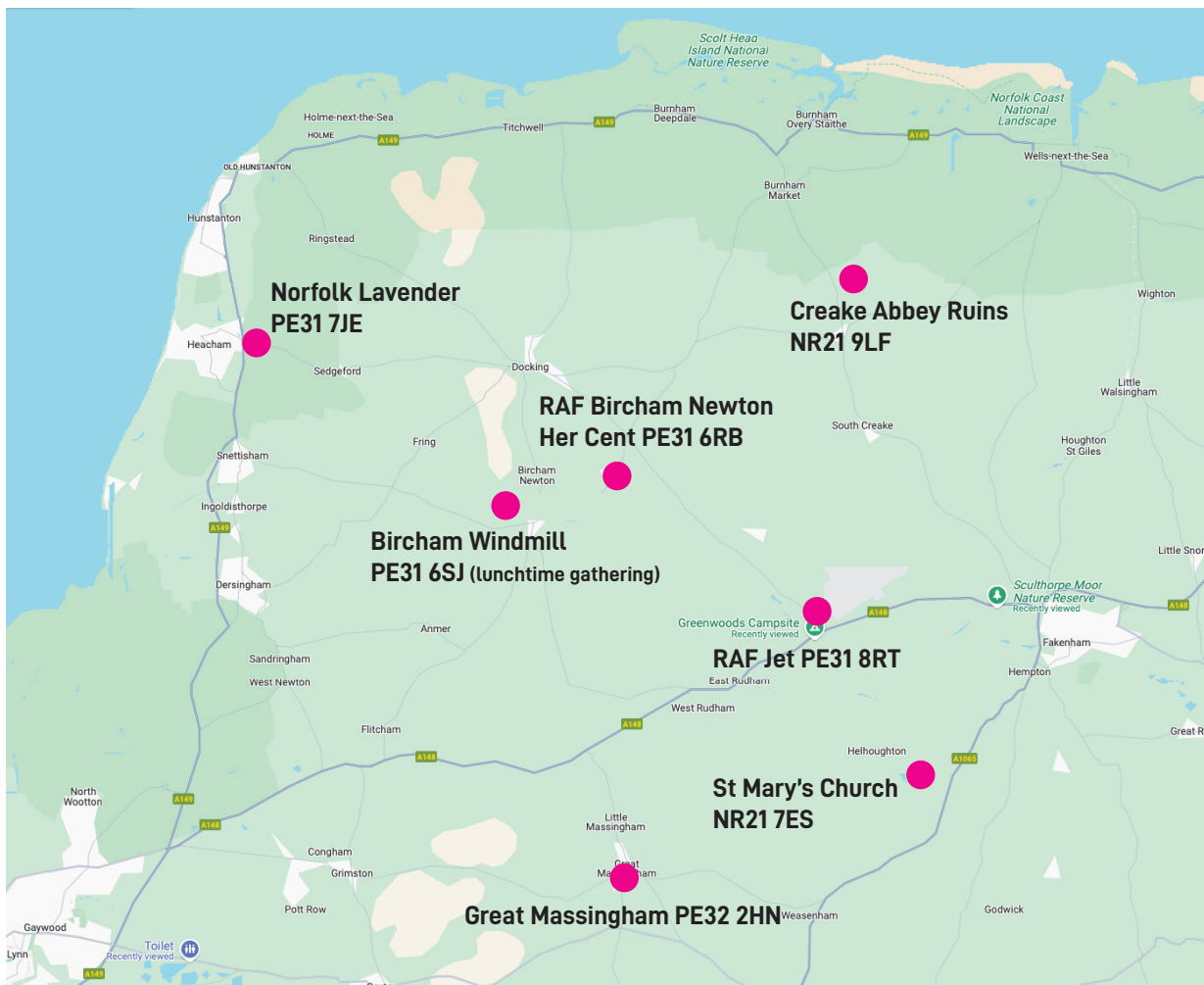
Photographing another Triumph at any stop point: 3pts for each different car.

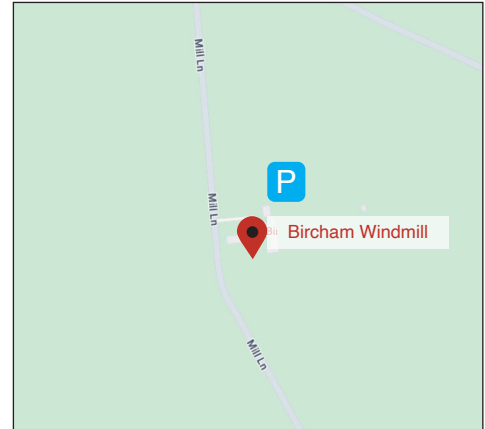
## Bircham Windmill, PE31 6SJ

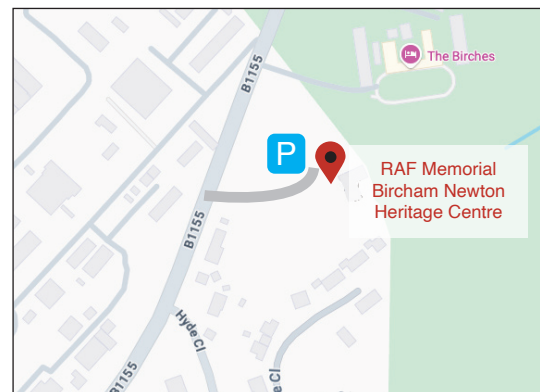
## RAF Memorial - Bircham Newton Heritage Centre, PE31 6RB

Museum is closed but well worth a future visit at a later date.



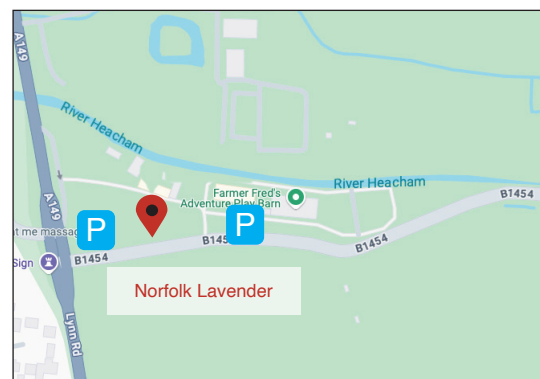
## Norfolk Lavender, PE31 7JE
