

Norfolk Triumph Scatter Treasure Hunt for Drive it Day, Sunday 27th April 2025

A 50 mile (approx) drive around mid Norfolk visiting sites and places of special interest you might not otherwise see.

You will need a camera/mobile phone camera, road map and a SatNav would be a distinct advantage. There aren't any start or finish points. Rather you choose the order in which you do the route. **Important! You need to arrive at your chosen start point between 10 and 10.30am.** There will be a short walk at each stop point to find the answers to the clues.

This year the **lunchtime gathering** will be at Whitwell and Reepham Station, NR10 4GA between 12 and 1pm with cafe and toilets.

Some of the venues could well be busy with members of the public - please be considerate to other visitors.

This is not a timed event, rather an enjoyable amble through the Norfolk countryside and we urge you to take the time to explore the places of interest we have chosen.

Some roads are narrow with blind bends. Please be careful of horses, cyclists and walkers.

We advise entrants not to bunch up or form convoys and to respect other road users.

Do as little or as much as you want. While it's not important to visit all the places, the more you do the better your chance of winning.

Points will be awarded as follows:

Correct answer: 3pts per clue

Photographing your car at any one stop point: 3pts (points only given once)

Photographing another Triumph at any stop point: 3pts for each different car.

Photographing (by your passenger obviously) another Triumph whilst driving: 5pts for each different car.

Note - Each car only allowed once. Points given for quiz answers only at Whitwell Station, no points will be given for photos.

And finally, it's the friendliness that makes these events, so if you see somebody walking around with a quiz sheet and a puzzled look on their faces say hi and be open to a brief chat. Most importantly have fun and enjoy!



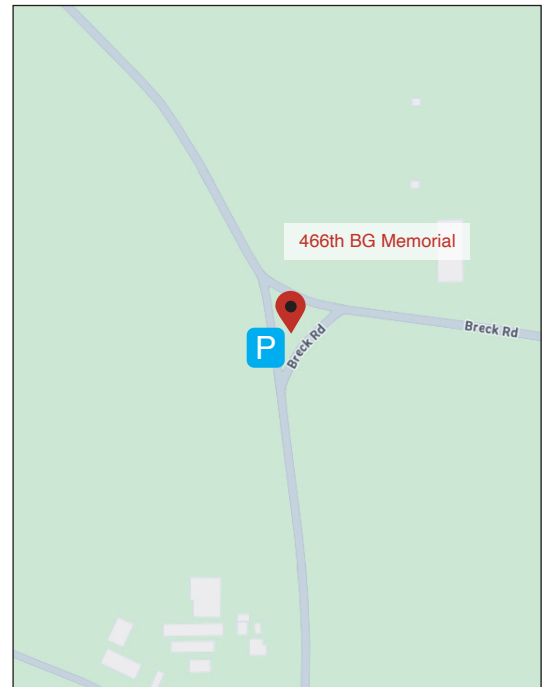
466th Bomb Group Memorial NR9 5LD

Clue 3: How many diamonds on the flying deck?



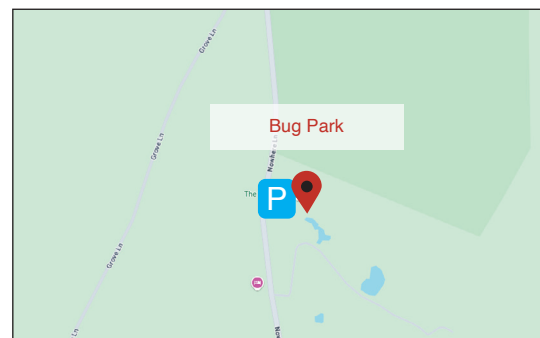
Bug Park, NR9 5PD

Clue 6: Last chance to order cooked food?



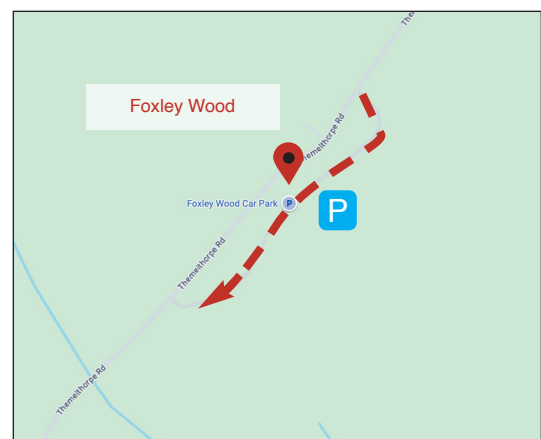
Foxley Wood, NR20 4QR

Clue 9: What's big and gets their own parking?

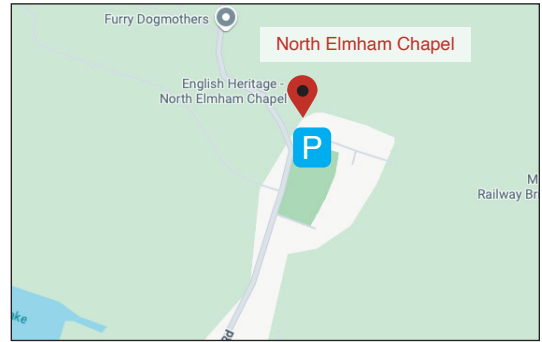


North Elmham Chapel NR20 5JU

Clue 12: What has the West Tower got that's unusual (5)?



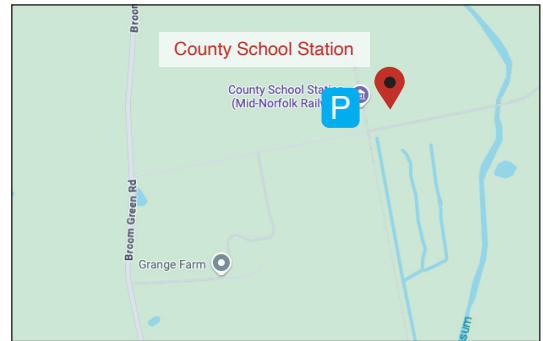
County School Station NR20 5LE

Clue 16: What's a loosely Triumph related drink?

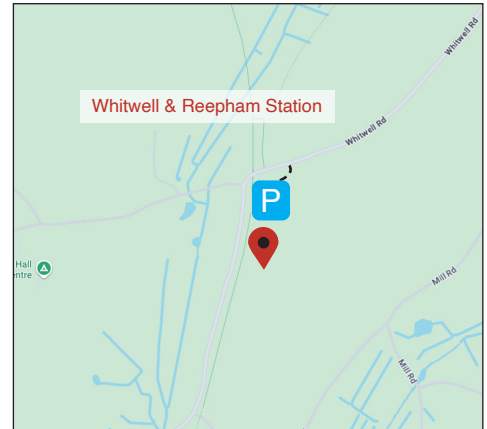

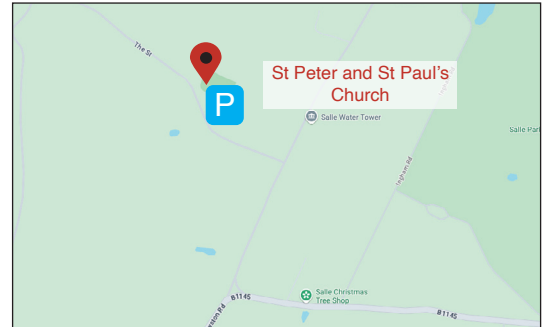


St Peter and St Paul's Church NR10 4SD

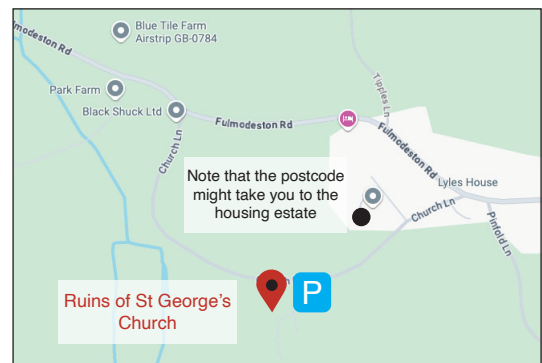


Ruins of St George's Church, Hindoleston NR20 5BT
