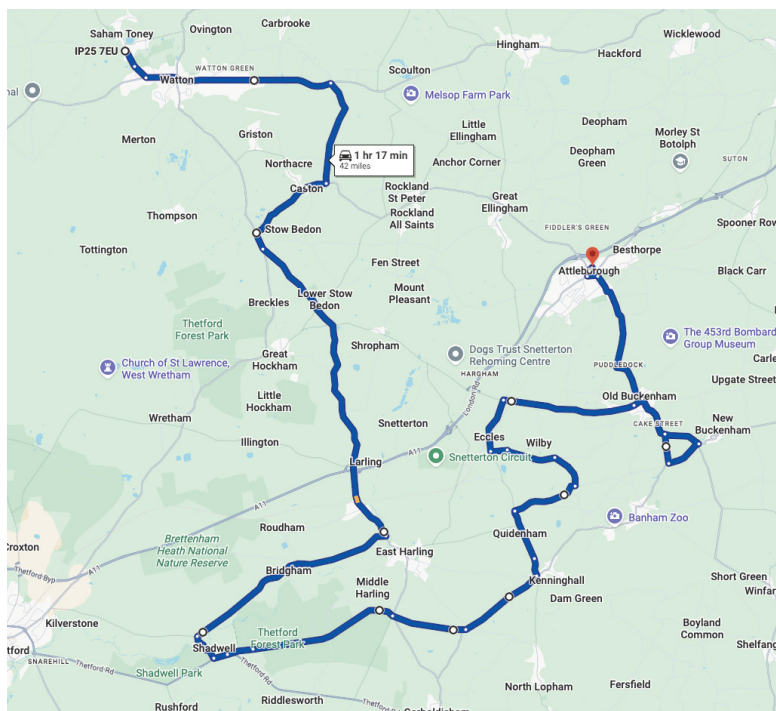


TSSC/T2KR Norfolk Tea and Cake Run 2026



Start from Queen's Square, Attleborough, NR17 2QW at 2pm.

Ending at 76 Richmond Road, Saham Toney, IP25 7EU

The route is approximately 30 miles and should take around 1 1/4 hours. You ideally need to be at the end before 4pm.

This is **NOT** a timed event, rather an enjoyable amble around the boundary of Norfolk. All timings are approximate and allow enough time to be able to drive sensibly.

You are advised to comply with all Road Traffic Regulations and Speed Limits.

Some roads are narrow with blind bends. Please be careful of horses, cyclists and walkers.

We advise entrants not to bunch up or form convoys and to respect other road users.

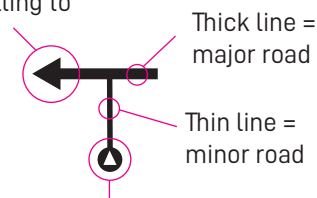
Everybody wants to travel at their own speed - if you find a trail of Triumphs behind you please pull over and let them pass.

You will need a clip board and a pen or pencil. Map/SatNav would also be useful.

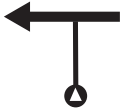
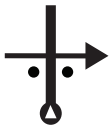
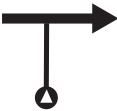
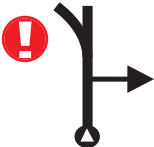
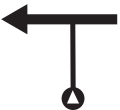
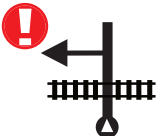
Most of the junctions are give way, so you don't have to worry too much until you come to a stop.

Junctions that go from a major to a minor road, which you will need to look out for, are marked

! Make sure you tick off each instruction as you go past them.

	Turn right out of car park
	Turn left at give way
	Go past church and turn right at lights, signed Diss B1077
	Stay on the B1077 over railway crossing...
	...and after 4 miles turn right at give way signed Kenninghall, Banham and zoo
	Take first right onto Doe Lane (unsigned)
	Turn left at give way (unsigned) and follow road back into Old Buckenham
	Take sharp left after pedestrian lights to carry on around the green
	After 2 ³ / ₄ go over railway crossing and turn left signed Quidenham, Eccles (sign knocked down)
	After 3 ¹ / ₂ miles (going through Eccles and Quidenham) turn right at give way (unsigned)

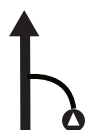

Almost at the end of the long straight before left bend sign, turn right (7.5T limit). Do not take the right at the crossroads.



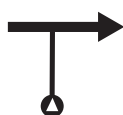
Go straight over at give way (unsigned)



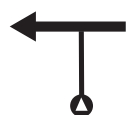
Carry on through the forest for just over 3 miles and turn right at give way



Take first right signed Shadwell



Turn right at give way



Go through Bridgham and turn left at give way onto B1111 signed Distillery



Navigator snooze time - stay on B1111 for 6 1/2 miles



...and turn right at give way signed Watton, Dereham onto A1075



Ignore immediate right turn and take next right signed Stow Bedon



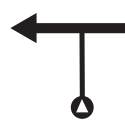
Go into Caston and turn right at give way

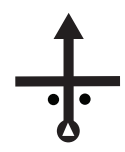
Leave Caston and turn left signed Watton, Carbrooke onto B1077



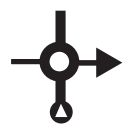
Turn left at give way signed Watton onto B1108



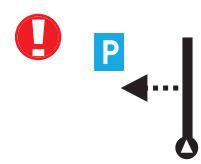
Continue into Watton and go over two mini roundabouts



Go straight over lights and onto Watton High Street (20mph)



Go through Watton and turn right at roundabout signed Saham Toney, Ashill



Go over bridge, past Broom Hall and just after layby on left turn left into 76 Richmond Road (IP25 7EU) and proceed to park on the grass.

NOTE: Please drive carefully, pedestrians will be using the same entrance.

Residential address with plenty of room for parking (classics only please*). Look out for the flag. Please come down the gravel driveway to the back garden. Turn right onto the grass and around to the left. Tea and cake will be served between 3-6pm. There will be a small number of members of the public attending, please make sure all valuables are locked away.

Please bring cash! There will be a voluntary donation box for the tea and cake. All proceeds to East Anglian Children's Hospices and club funds.

***NOTE:** There won't be parking on the premises for modern cars. Please either park in the layby or at Wells Cole Community Centre, Bell Lane.

When leaving, please be considerate and remember this is a residential area.
